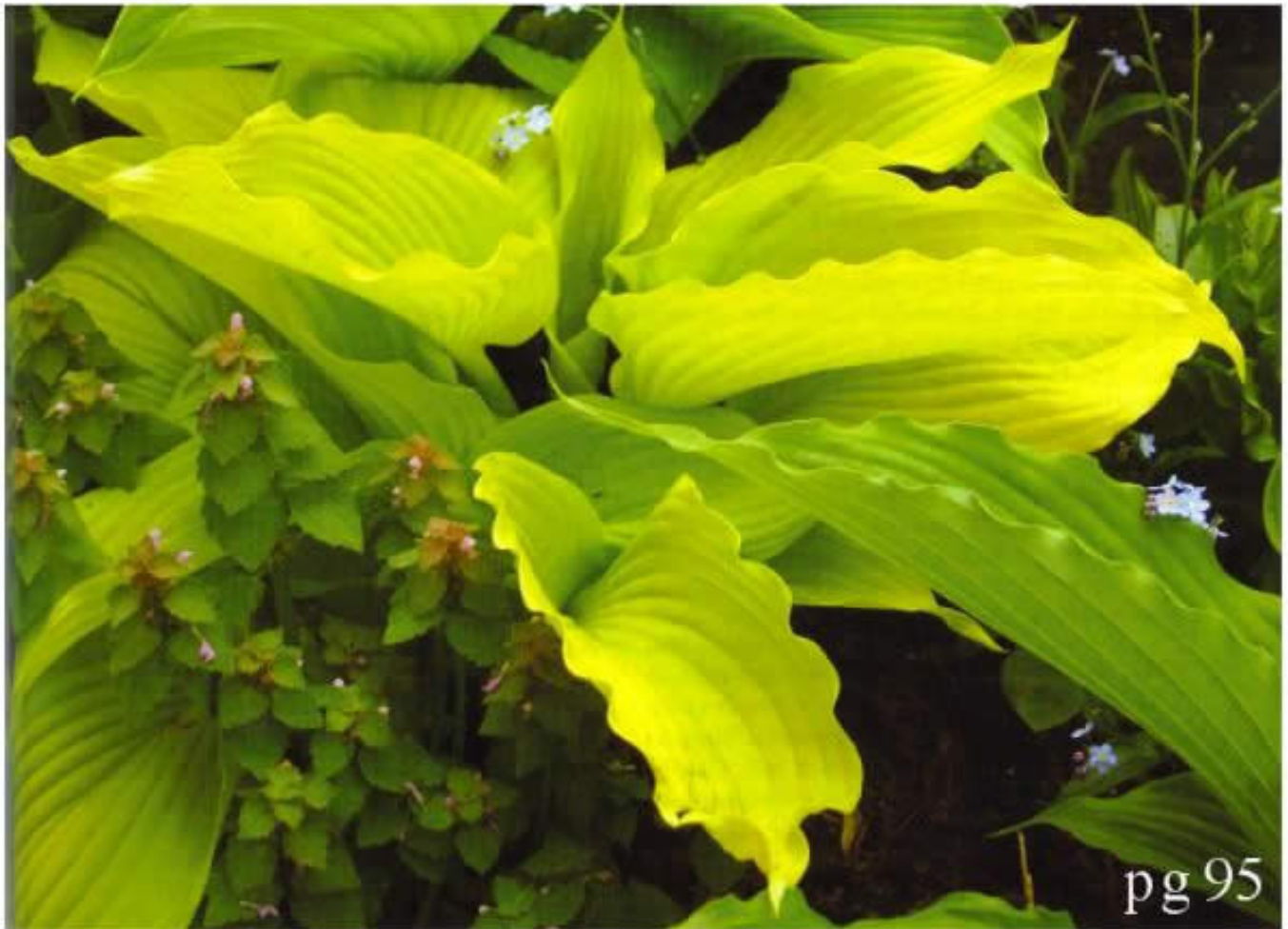


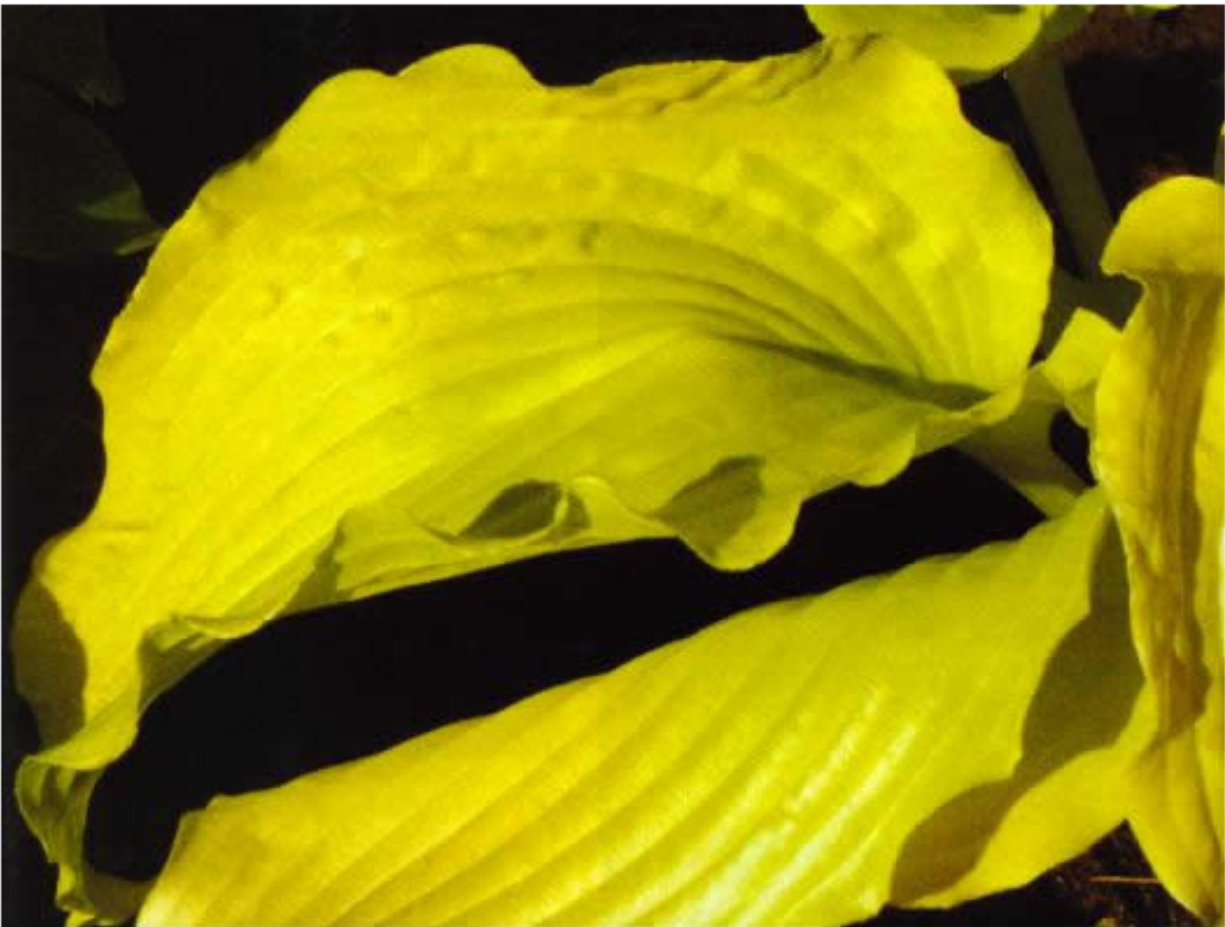
H. 'Atom Smasher' (Livingston) has fabulous wavy, lancifolia-type leaves of pure, intense gold. Its lavender flowers are followed by bright red and yellow pods which are simply amazing. Fast growing and fertile. A superb and dazzling variety. Will blow your mind!

H. 'Baja Sunset' (Livingston) is what golden gardens are all about. This amazing hosta has more glow than a glowworm in low, evening or morning light.





H. 'Elvis On Stage' (Livingston) move over Elvis, even the King himself (and I am a big Elvis fan) was not as dazzling as this hosta that takes centre stage. Utter glowing glory, flashy corrugated yellow leaves are in the spotlight here. Attractively tapered and rippled they outshine everything else. Good substance. Gold hostas do not come any better than this. Applause please for the King of *Hosta*!



H. 'Glorious' (Livingston) is a lovely graceful plant with thick, glossy, waxy, undulating leaves which turn golden in sun. Small but a fast grower. Bud and scape bases are vibrant red. Lavender striped flowers.



H. 'Made You Look' (Asch 2000) is quite an unusual colouring, emerging lime, leaves turn variegated, pale yellow in the centre with golden yellow margins. Lime petioles and leaf scapes, topped by white flowers.



‘H. Maya Swingtime’ (Alttara Scheer) Starts our chartreuse and will stay so in the shade, but with some sun soon turns yellow. A very attractive, deeply veined variety. A definite swinger.

H. 'Stand Up' (Livingston) is a dayglow, iridescent yellow which takes some sun. Hard to beat colour, deeply veined and slightly puckerd, upright growing leaves with a lovely white reverse. Heavy substance and white flowers round this off nicely.



H. 'Wee One' (Livingston) has gorgeous yellow leaves with a slight wave, deeply veined with slight puckering, and pinkish purple buds.



H. 'Xanadu Dlanor' (Skaggs) is a sport of '*Little Aurora*' with the vigour and garden worthiness of its parent. The yellow leaf has a green watermark, deeper in the centre. Very striking.



H. 'Yellow Ice' (Livingston) will set you afire and your garden ablaze, with pure yellow young leaves, conspicuous veining, a tantalising ripple to the leaf.
